Review and restock annually.

### 2. MAKE A PLAN.

Are you evacuating or sheltering in place? Plan for the possibility of both scenarios.

### 3. STAY INFORMED.

## TO USE A PET-FRIENDLY SHELTER YOU MUST:

Bring proof of current rabies vaccination and license for dogs and cats.

Place pet on a leash or in a carrier.

Bring a crate large enough for your pet to stand up and turn around in. Cats need crates or carriers large enough to contain litter and food/water.

Bring pet supplies.

Arrive early. Shelters fill quickly!
