Before you pick up your dog:

- Sign up! Please visit this <u>link</u> to register and sign up in advance. There will be pre-selected dogs that you may pick from when you arrive at the shelter.
- Prepare for anything!
- Ready your car with the appropriate amount of space for a larger dog.
- We recommend that you leave your dog at home. The purpose is to give the shelter dogs one on one time with humans.
- If you take the dog home, please ensure there are no holes in your fence, your pets stay separated, and the shelter dog is never left on their own.

Picking Up Your Dog:

- Once you have selected a dog from the list grab your DDO go-bag stocked with: medical history, harness and leash, water bowl, poo bags, wet wipes, treats, a hold card, instructions, and ADOPT ME vest.
- Confirm the dog is leaving with the appropriate staff member.

Doggie Day Out!

- You are welcome to take your dog to one of the suggested locations, or your home!
- Please avoid dog parks and keep your dog on a leash and harness at all times.
- We want someone to fall in love with them, please have them wear their ADOPT ME vest!
- If someone wants to adopt (fingers crossed!) please have them fill out the hold card in the DDO go-bag. When you return to the shelter, please give it to the staff.
